AUCTION HELD ON-SITE AT THE WEINBERG FARM AT THE NORTH EDGE OF QUINCY, IL.

From the junction of Int. 172 and Columbus Rd, go west to the 4-way stop, turn right & go north on Cannonball Rd approx. 3/4 mile to Rd 1400N (Ambiance Corner) then east & north 1/2 mile.

Session 4 of the Donald Weinberg Estate marks the 9th & 10th days of one of the largest auctions ever held in the Midwest. Donnie had an eye for rare and unusual items. He collected most of his life and acquired a staggering collection. Session 5 will be January 19, 20 & 21, 2017 and will be held at Sullivan & Son Auction Center, south of Carthage, IL.
