

Location of Property from Mt Ayr, IA:

Conveniently located on Hwy 2 approximately 2 miles west of Mt Ayr with multiple access points!

General Description:

The property offers some of the lowa's best Deer, Turkey, Pheasant, Quail, Duck, Geese, Mourning Dove, small game & Morel mushrooms. Indian Artifacts such as arrowheads, primitive tools & tomahawks have been found throughout the property.

Land Descripton:

Out of the 150 acres m/l, There is also 32 acres m/l of hardwood timber with no easements. The timber offers an abundance of mature Oak, Walnut, Hickory & Buckeye trees. The timber has never been harvested and offers a possible source of income. When entering this timber you know immediately that the best hunting ground awaits you!! 118 acres m/l of WRP and holds a beautifully diverse grassland which includes 2 marshes with the ability to control the water level year round. The grassland has a great mixture of Native Grass, Flowers, Plumbs & Turnips for additional food sources. It also borders a neighboring farm with 50 acres of crop ground that also serves as a great food plot.

Hunting Overview:

Deer: The property is home to some of the best deer in the state. There have been 180-190 class deer harvested on the property and neighboring farms. There are deep proven genetics in this area that will not disappoint! The property offers endless possibilities of hunts in the grassland or timber for that next MONSTER BUCK!!

<u>Turkey:</u> The timber and creek lines offer great turkey hunts. A great number of long beards are roosting & lurking throughout the property. During the spring second season, there were 30+ turkeys that came into the decoys & you could hear the gobbles calling you!!

Pheasant/Quail: This property holds a great number of Upland Game, as it has been a focus to build one of the best upland farms in the state. Pheasants & quail are abundant throughout the property due to the diversity of grass, cover & food sources available. Like the turkeys, the pheasants will be cackling and the quail calling "Bob-White" throughout the day begging you to come hunt!! **Ducks/Geese:** It is well known in the Mt Ayr/Hwy 2 area that this is the farm that holds the waterfowl. The 2 controllable marshes are the
